

# STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY



#### Help for non-English speakers

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Mirniyan Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- support Mirniyan Primary School's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community.

#### **SCOPE**

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

#### **UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE**

Mirniyan Primary School's compulsory school uniform items are listed in Appendix A of this policy

#### **General appearance**

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- Uniforms should be clearly marked with the owner's name
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these undergarments are completely hidden
- Studs and sleepers are the only acceptable jewellery
- No make up or nail polish.



## **Health and safety**

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of lice and for student safety.

Jewellery, nails, hair accessories and similar items are not permitted.

School uniform hats must be worn outside from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 30<sup>th</sup> April and on any other day prescribed by the school. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time period, by parent or student choice.

Hats are not to be worn inside.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

Mirniyan Primary will in the future operate a second-hand uniform store for parents.

The School Council has considered affordability in the development of this dress code. However, if you are facing difficulty meeting uniform costs the <u>Help with school costs and fees</u> page provides advice on support offered by the Victorian Government. If your child is starting prep or year 7 and is eligible to receive support via the <u>Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund</u>, you may be eligible to access the Affordable School Uniform (ASU) program.

Please the Business Manager, Sharon Steele, to discuss support that we may be able to provide.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION**

Mirniyan Primary School will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website and in enrolment packs. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.

If a student is out of school uniform or otherwise breaches the Student Dress Code on a recurring basis, a note will be provided to the student and parents by the classroom teacher. If non-compliance with the dress code becomes a continued occurrence, the Assistant Principal will be informed, and a phone call home may be required. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.



Measures taken by Mirniyan Primary School to address concerns about student non-compliance with the Student Dress Code will also be addressed in accordance with our Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy.

#### **EXEMPTIONS TO STUDENT DRESS CODE**

We acknowledge that there might be instances where the enforcement of this dress code could impact students differently.

Students and their parents or carers may apply in writing to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:

- an aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic or cultural beliefs or background
- the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code
- the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular financial hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:

- consider the grounds for the exemption request
- explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers
- encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.

The Principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.

#### CONCERNS ABOUT THIS STUDENT DRESS CODE

## **APPENDIX A: MIRNIYAN PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM ITEMS**

#### All year round

The following items may be worn all year round, with either the summer or winter uniform:

#### Windcheater

Navy V- neck windcheater with school logo

#### Jacket

Navy jacket with school logo

## Rugby jumper Grade 5 & 6 only

Navy rugby jumper with school logo

#### **Polo shirts**

Navy long and short sleeved with school logo.

#### **Scooter Skorts**

Plain navy skorts without decoration or brand name and in winter can be worn with navy blue tights/stockings.

#### **Pants**

Plain, navy-blue track, tracksuit or Gebardine pants without decoration or brand name

#### **Socks or tights**

Navy blue or white socks (no logo must be visible) Navy blue tights

## **Footwear**

Appropriate footwear is to be worn. Black school shoes or all Black Only runners (no other colours) with no brand names. Laces to be plain black

Other sport specific runners may only be worn to PE or Sport lessons, or inter-school sport events and students must be able to tie laces if required.

## Mesh Bucket Hat/Beanie

Bucket hat and Beanie Navy with school logo

#### Rain Jacket

Navy, Other colours may be worn to and from school

## Scarf

Navy with school logo or a plain navy may be worn to and from school

### Headwear

Navy blue, sky blue, or gold yellow or white, hair ribbons, elastic bands or "scrunchies" or headwear worn as part of cultural/religious beliefs.



#### **Dresses**

Summer blue, gold and white checked dress Box pleat tunic with sky skivvy

#### **Shorts**

Plain navy-blue shorts without decoration or brand name

# Hats - to be worn from 1st August to 30 April

Navy broadbrim mesh bucket hat with school logo
